Over the years, the business expanded and now, Dee's Childcare operates from a newly refurbished setting offering care in a bright, clean, safe and homely environment for children aged 6 months to 11 years.

With a team of friendly, qualified assistants, Dee's Childcare goes above and beyond to offer the children stimulating learning experiences, healthy lifestyle and a safe place to learn, grow and play.

We love outdoors and we are part of the Forest Childcare Association. We are great believers that children learn best outside the classroom when they are free to explore, take risks, and build resilience.

We provide weekly visits to our allotment, woodlands, parks, farms and now at our new setting, we are very fortunate to have our very own enchanted gardens.

One of the things that set us apart from other childcare settings is our commitment to provide weekly opportunities to take the children out into the community. Outings range from going shopping, observing modes of transport or socializing at playgroups or music sessions and more.

Furthermore, we have associated with Lingotots Bexley, to bring weekly French lessons in the day-care for those who are interested.

We work in partnership with parents and seek to support, nurture and encourage that special relationship. We understand that, on occasion, there are end of day pressures that means parents simply don't have time to discuss their child's progress. Recognising this, we use Baby's Days, a secure online portal to enable parents to follow their child's progress, view their picture gallery or, perhaps, just to watch a video of messy play that day. Daily general updates are also provided on our WhatsApp Parents Forum. Dee's Childcare offers a truly all-inclusive service, all year round offering Holiday Club during half Terms and Summer Break.





\* Breakfast, mid-morning snack, lunch and afternoon snack. We provide healthy foods and only use Almond or Coconut milk.

There will be an additional charge for food and drinks, for children attending on the 30 hours entitlement. As Government funding in England covers the delivery of early education and care only and does not include food or resources.

- \*\*Sensory play, messy play, arts and crafts, dressing up, role play, soft play, reading and singing sessions, yoga classes, French classes(at additional cost) and weekly Black History Sessions.
- \*\*\*Weekly trips and outings to playgroups, allotment, playgrounds and parks, fields and woodlands, farms and local community area.
- \*\*\*Yearly trips to opticians, dentist, Fire Station, Police Station as part of learning about people in the community who help us.

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This is the best childcare team in the world, and we lived in UK, USA, Italy, and Switzerland. The range of activities and the services provided are really exceptional, including a little bit of farming, which is soo important for children living in a city.

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# Opening hours and Fees Pees Pees

At this time, we have availability which could potentially suit your requirements and we would be happy to welcome you and your child into the Dee's Childcare extended family. Outlined below are the initial key elements of our admissions policy and procedure, should you wish to progress further.

#### **Opening Hours:** 7.30am till 6.30pm Monday to Friday.

All children must be collected by 6.30pm a late collection fee of £10.00 per 15 minutes (or part of) is payable. (Earlier or later hours can be arranged at an additional fee of £10.00 per hour).

**Retainer Fee:** To retain a space for 6 weeks or more we require you to complete a registration form and pay one-week non-refundable retainer fee.

<u>Deposit</u>: Once a place has been accepted you will be required to pay a one week's refundable deposit and complete a contract and all necessary documentation.

<u>Payments:</u> Fees are payable in full for all contracted days including when child/children are sick, bank holidays, school closures, parent holidays, doctor appointments, bad weather, parent's days off and staff training days.

#### Fees:

Our fees are very competitive for this area, and can be hourly, daily or weekly based on individual needs. Fees are calculated monthly/weekly in advance and payments are due on 1st of the month. A late payment fee of £10.00 will be charged for each day payment is late.

With effect from 1st January 2021 All fees are inclusive of VAT

#### Full-time: Charges per full week

Caterpillars Room (0 - 2years) = £330.00Cocoons Room (3 - 4years) = £300.00

Butterflies (5-8 years) = £125.00 per week (PM only)

#### Part-time: Charges per day

Caterpillars Room (0 - 2 years) = £70.00 Full DayCocoons Room (3 - 4 years) = £65.00 Full Day

Butterflies (5 - 8 years) = £25.00 Casual hourly rate = £8.00

#### Unsocial hours (outside of normal working hours) £10.00 per hour

Contracts can be Full Time, Part Time, Term Time\* or Casual\* (\*incurs an additional retainer fee)
•We accept Childcare Vouchers, offer the 15 & 30 hours free entitlement and Together4Twos. You

Holidays: Two weeks paid holiday, (usually one week over Christmas, one over Easter) At least Four weeks prior notice will be provided





- The safety of children, staff, and families is paramount.
- This is a learning process, considerations may evolve and be built upon as the situation changes and new precautionary measures and practices may be introduced.
- It is important that everyone complies with the latest Government guidance on Coronavirus.

#### The key elements to keep everyone safe at nursery are:

- Any pupil, staff member, parent or visitor with Corona virus symptoms must not attend nursery and must isolate at home.
- We will be taking children's temperature every morning at drop off.
- Increased cleaning processes are in place, throughout and at the end of the day
- Children and team members will be social distancing as far as possible.
- Children will stay in key groups (a bubble) each day.
- Arrival and departure will be staggered and children will be dropped off at the entrance.
   Parents need to sanitize and while waiting outside please maintain social distancing.
- Parents will not come on site or visit the nursery rooms unless this is explicitly arranged with the Nursery Manager e.g. in the event of a child being distressed.
- Parents and staff members will wear masks during drop off and collection at nursery.

### Our Daycare



Dee's Childcare is the place where children learn, play and grow. This is our motto. This is the forefront of setting up any space for the children in our care.

Our new setting is newly refurbished into a clean, warm, homely space. We've created a bright natural learning environment with open ended natural resources. Furthermore, we benefit from an enclosed enchanted garden for Forest Childcare Experiences.

Each of our rooms are bright and airy, age specific, in compliance with National Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum and directives.

We've created a special room for each age group which we fondly name:



Caterpillars: 0-2 years old



Cocoons: 3-4 years old



Butterflies: 5-11 years old





Within each room are curriculum based areas, corresponding to the EYFS seven areas of learning, as well as an area for sleep and quiet time, and plenty of space to play.



Butterflies have access to a computer station and quiet area to complete homework.

All children gather in the main dining area at meal times or collective activities and have the opportunity to socialize, help each other and play together.

Dees child care was a home away from home. The attention and care provided to children is exceptional. - It is important that social distancing continues to be maintained.




#### **Daily routine**

During the nursery day we aim to provide the children a wide range of activities which enables them to build a variety of new skills.

Our daily schedule is generally divided as follows:



- Morning session could be an adult led activity, an outing, story and song time, morning snack and outdoor play in the garden
- Lunch





Afternoon session consists of interaction with all age groups children, free play, child led play, afternoon snack and outdoor play in the garden.



Children thrive on routine and consistency and we are dedicated to create a positive environment where children feel secure, safe and loved.

# Healthy Living



Aside our daily time in the fresh air and the exercise that comes with it, we also believe in providing nutritious, delicious food, freshly cooked on site, by staff who have Level 2/3 in Food Hygiene.

Children in full-time day care can receive up to 90% of their daily food intake from our meals. We recognise that a nutritious and balanced diet helps set the foundations for lifelong food preferences, making it essential that children eat well during their formative years.

As part of our commitment to providing the children with a healthy diet, our menus, you will notice are mainly plant-based, created in conjunction with the Change4Life website.

The staff are currently working towards the Healthy Early Years London Awards.

#### **General Information about our menus**

#### **Food Safety**

Food is stored, prepared and presented in a safe and hygienic environment.

All the staff preparing and handling food have gained a Food Hygiene Certificate.

We also insist to teach children basic hygiene skills, such as not eating food that has fallen on the floor, and washing their hands with soap and warm water before eating meals or snacks and after going to the toilet or handling animals.

#### Plant based

We have such a love for nature and all things coming from it, which enhance the children's learning and growing experiences. To this end, we grow our own vegetables at the allotment.

Our menus favour a more plant based selection.

#### **Drinks**

We offer plant based milks and fresh drinking water which is available and easily accessible throughout the day.

# Working with Parents

At Dee's Childcare we value parents as partners and understand the importance of this relationship in ensuring that your child thrives, both emotionally and academically, whilst in our care. Using Baby's Days the most advanced, interactive child care management system available, we provide daily updates on your child's progress and achievements.





Baby's Days allows us to form this partnership with you, simply and effectively. When you connect to our system you will be able to view numerous areas of the system including Daily Notes, Toileting, Sleep Times, Progress, Photograph Galleries, Policies, Permissions and Invoices etc. Within the Daily Notes you can read about your child's daily activities and leave comments for us to read and respond to. Within the Progress section parents can read Progress and Observation notes, view photographs and see exactly what development level you child is currently at. In addition, you can read, agree to, and digitally sign acceptance of our Policies and Permissions and also view and print your weekly/monthly invoices. But best of all, the system is fully interactive enabling you to add/share photos and observations of your child's achievements at home, therefore, providing a complete development record between home and your childcare provider

Considering that close to 8% of an OFSTED inspection grades the effectiveness of the parent partnership, it is imperative that we form a good working partnerships with all of the parents of the children in our care. We must be able to communicate a steady flow of information regarding your child's progress, activities, development and more and be able to demonstrate how we do this during our inspection.



# The Early Years Foundation Stage

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is the framework followed by all early years settings following the British Curriculum. This is a child centred curriculum, which places play and exploration at the forefront of the child's learning journey.

The EYFS framework guides staff to provide meaningful learning opportunities across the 7 areas of learning and development, outlined below:

#### Physical Development

Children are provided with opportunities to be active and interactive, to develop their coordination, control and movement. Children begin to understand the importance of physical activity, and to make healthy food choices.

#### Mathematics

Involves providing children with opportunities to develop and strengthen their skills in counting, understanding and using numbers. They calculate simple addition and subtraction problems and describe shapes space and measure.

#### Communication and Language Development

Children are given opportunities to experience a rich language environment, to develop their confidence and skills in expressing themselves. They speak and listen in a range of situations.

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children develop a positive sense of self, forming positive relationships with others. develop social skills and learn how to manage their feelings. They understand appropriate behaviour in groups, and have confidence in their own abilities.

#### Expressive Arts and Design

Children explore and play with a wide range of media and materials, as well as providing opportunities and encouragement for sharing their thoughts, ideas and feelings. They experience art, music, dance, movement and role play.

#### **Literacy Development**

Children begin to link sounds and letters and begin to read and write. Children are given access to a range of reading materials (books, poems, and other reading materials) to ignite their interests.

#### Understanding the World

Involves guiding children to make sense of their physical world and their community through opportunities to explore, observe, and find out about peoples, places, technology and the environment.

# The Early Years Foundation Stage



These 7 areas are used to plan your child's learning and activities. The professionals teaching and supporting your child will make sure that the activities are suited to your child's unique needs. This is a little bit like a curriculum in primary and secondary schools, but it's suitable for very young children, and it's designed to be really flexible so that staff can follow your child's unique needs and interests.

Children in the EYFS learn by playing and exploring, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside.



# As a mum or dad, how you can help with your child's learning?

All the fun activities that you do with your child at home are important in supporting their learning and development, and have a really long lasting effect on your child's learning as they progress through school.

Even when your child is very young and is not yet able to talk, talking to them helps them to learn and understand new words and ideas. If you make the time every day to do some of the following things with your child it will make a real difference to your child's confidence as a young learner.

## **Community Partnerships**

- Dee's Childcare has been a part of the local community for almost 20 years.
- Therefore, we have built strong relationships with other local services to provide the children the best experiences to enhance their learning.
- We work in close partnerships with many local children centres, libraries, schools, nurseries and some small independent businesses.
- We are regular visitors to Plumstead Children Centre and Library, Woolwich Library, Thamesmead Library where we attend playgroups, singing and story time sessions.
- We do school runs for Notre Dame Primary School, Eglinton Primary School, Plumcroft Primary School, Foxfield Primary School and St Patricks Primary School.
- Lingotots Bexley, offers language lessons and for more than 5 years we have affiliated with them to bring this opportunity to the children in our care. Once a week, a tutor comes to the day care and delivers a French lesson for the children whose parents wish them to attend, due to the additional cost. Prior to Covid-19 restrictions we also participated in the Lingotots Generations programme, where sessions were held in a local elderly care home, where the children interacted with the elderly residents.
- Windyrush Farm is a family owned inner-city-farm in Belvedere.
   They regularly welcome our visits so that the children can have close contact and interactions with the animals by observing, petting and helping to feed them.
